Find the verbs in the past simple and write them in the boxes.




Yesterday I <u>went</u> to the playground near my house. I <u>had</u> a lot of fun. I <u>played</u> on the swings and the slide but I <u>didn't go</u> on the roundabout. I <u>saw</u> my best friend there. We <u>talked</u> about her birthday and she <u>invited</u> me to her party. Afterwards I <u>didn't want</u> to go home!

saw	talked	invited	didn't want

We can use the **past simple** to talk about things we did in the past. The past simple ending is -ed for regular verbs: play – played, watch – watched, want – wanted Irregular verbs have a special form: eat – ate, write – wrote, go – went For the negative, don't change the main verb. Use 'didn't' instead: play – didn't play, eat – didn't eat
